Dear Maria

I send you
\$700 - we were p^d day before
yesterday I got a letter
from you to day & find
my horse is not on the way
from Brattleboro I am very
sorry he is not coming - I
am in great need of a horse
and cant get one here now
If he is not already on his way
have Father send him to N.Y.
immediately and transportation
can be got by applying to Genl S -
We are some expecting another
attack here and at Newbern
and we are very busy building
barracks & works &c if the Rebels
come again they will repeat
I assure you - I want the
horse if it costs \$700 to get him
here
