My Dear Wife

As Counsel is going home tomorrow I will write a few lines, and let you know I am well. You will see by this I am going to enlarge my correspondence a little as small envelopes are by far too small. We have been out for target practice this forenoon and this afternoon we are to have a Brigade drill. What are you doing today my dear? practicing I suppose little thinking that you are to be so soon agreeably surprised but you are. I trust you be happy to have him here at home again? I shall expect to hear from you soon. I send a can of milk along by C. G. so you can see what we use and if you have a chance show some of it to Mother White. Please try a little in your coffee?
