I write to inform

you of the successful erection of the statue
on the dome of the State House, and permit
me to say it looks grand. It has a better
effect than I had anticipated. Everybody seems
pleas'd. I believe even Mr Powers is well satisfied.
A bill for an appropriation ^{to Ethan Allen statue} not exceeding
one thousand dollars has passed through the
Senate unanimous, and comes to the house
of Representatives tomorrow. I have great hopes
that it will pass the House. —

Mr Powers told me yesterday that if I
would get your acknowledgment or acceptance
